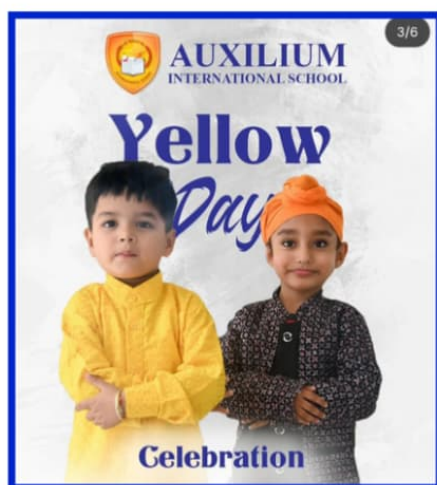

YELLOW DAY CELEBRATION

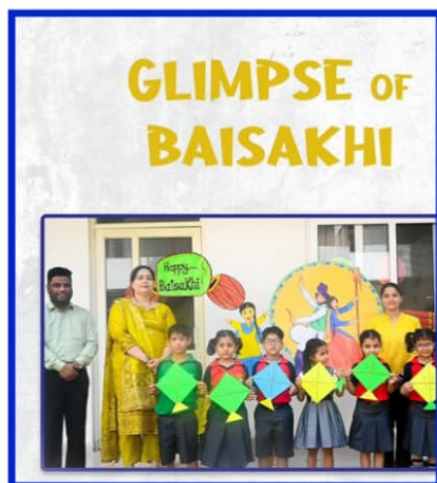
